The project is a landscapes initiative for family and community revival cohesiveness towards a sustainable future. Kumasi is a populous city of about two (2) million people, 50.2% males, and 48.8% females of which 39.2% as children. It is located in the transitional forest zone and is about 270km north of the national capital, Accra with an area of about 254 square kilometres. .

devous for the community. LaNCoR + will serve to foster self-help attitude and initiative within the community and also provide opportunities for training and employment for the youth in Appiadu, Kumasi and Ghana.

LaNCoR + AIMS TO:

- Creatively develop open spaces and landscapes into a play grounds and recreational place for children and parents.
- The Christus Kinder Paradise will be an outdoor and indoor play area for kids. It will have children's play equipment developed from recycled materials.



- This will assist children in developing their talents through psychomotor activity.
- Psychomotor socio-cultural models depicting most prominent cultural sites from the ten regions of Ghana dubbed Ghana at a glance.
- Raise awareness of parents and children on childcare, delinquency and health issues through education and sensitization programs.



SOFT PROJECT DELIVERABLES

- Development of Neighbourhood Cohesion Instrument;
- Formation of Self-Help Clubs and Groups like; LaNCoR-Mums, LaNCoR-Kids, LaNCoR-Scouts, LaNCoRManagers;
- Organisation of Art and Craft Workshops for Kids and Families;andTraditional choreography session for young talents;
- Organisation of Design Competition for Architecture and Art Students from Kwame Nkrumah Science and Technology for Playing Equipments from recycled materials and layout concepts;
- Organisation of Counselling and Workshop sessions on Health and Child Care issues

TARGET GROUP AND BENEFICIARIES

The project is for the children, youth and the parents of Appiadu, Kumasi and the entire of Ghana. The project when completed is anticipated to attract tourists from near and far around and beyond Ghana. Bringing together children, young adults, parents, tourist, commoners and royalty to experience and learn about every region of Ghana on one common ground.

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

An international student's workshop will precede the actual construction of the project in Kumasi from **10th April 2015 to 1st May 2015**. The workshop will bring together about 24 students both local and international students with backgrounds in Architecture, Design, urban /settlement planning, landscape architecture and creative arts working together in teams under the watchful supervision of renowned industry experts. The workshop is expected to come out with conceptual drawings of the following: Christus Kinder Paradise with the following deliverables;

- Outdoor and indoor Playground for Kids of age groups 0-3, 4-8 and 9-14
- Outdoor psychomotor socio-cultural models depicting all important cultural edifices in the 10 regions of Ghana -Theme: Ghana @ a Glance. Development of playing equipments for Kids using recycled materials

It will present an opportunity for students to improve their skills and also gain new ones from renowned industry experts and also discover new areas of interest. It will also present hands-on exposure to real life expectations and challenges of the industry. Participants will also receive certificates of participation at the close of the workshop. 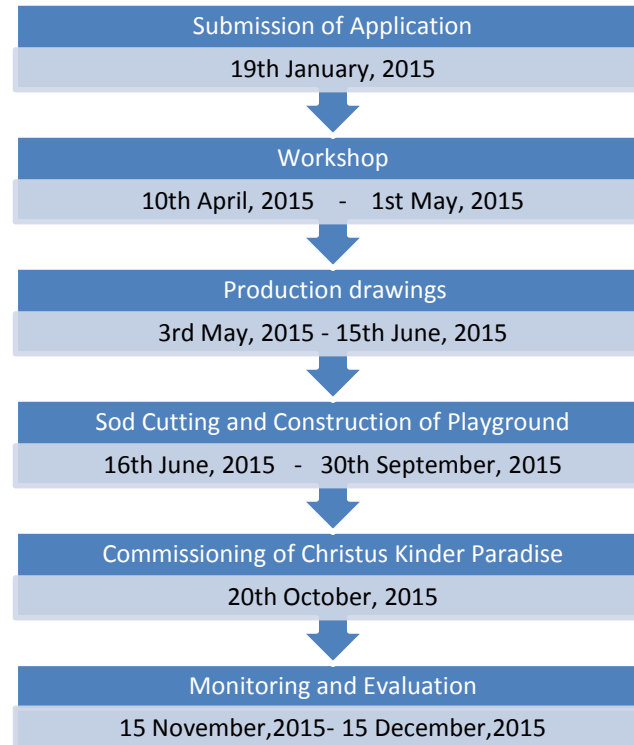

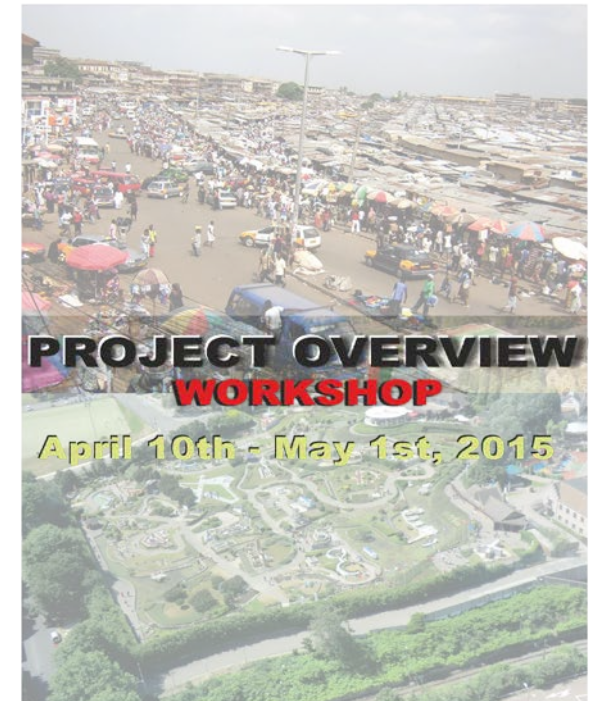
